Jacquard fabric inspired by Ogata Korin paintings, a painter and lacquerer active during mid-17th century of the Rinpa school in Japan. The fan, dating back to China early as the second century B.C. born perhaps as imitation of the wing mechanism of the bat, was a symbol of aristocratic and artistic language. This fabric enhances it with its shine and with meticulous research of textile effects and is available in nine contemporary colors. Fabric suitable for upholstery and curtains.
